Responsibilities of FUSE Board of Representatives

- Be familiar with the collective bargaining agreement
- Meet regularly as a committee to discuss issues/concerns in your building and to identify ways to play a positive role in the resolution of those concerns
- Meet regularly with building administration
- Attend monthly Board of Reps meetings
- Act as a liaison between members in your building and FUSE Leadership Team
- Represent the concerns of members in the building at monthly Board of Reps meetings
- Report to members in your building issues discussed at monthly Board of Reps meetings
- Represent members at meetings with administrators when members face disciplinary action
- Assist members in your building to resolve work-related problems
- Working with the FUSE Grievance Chairperson, identify and assist in the resolutions of grievances
- Assist in fostering communications between the union's leadership and the membership by distributing notices, newsletters and maintaining the FUSE bulletin board in your building

This sure sounds like a lot, but it really isn't — not when you are part of an active committee working together, sharing these responsibilities.

Know that the union's leadership team is here to support and help you in what ever ways we can.
